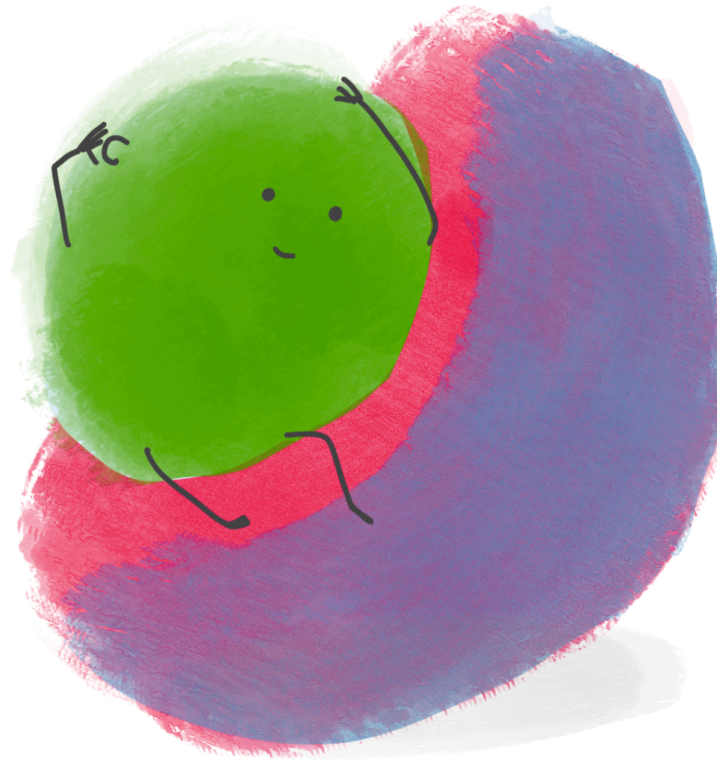




Curious explorer

thinking before acting



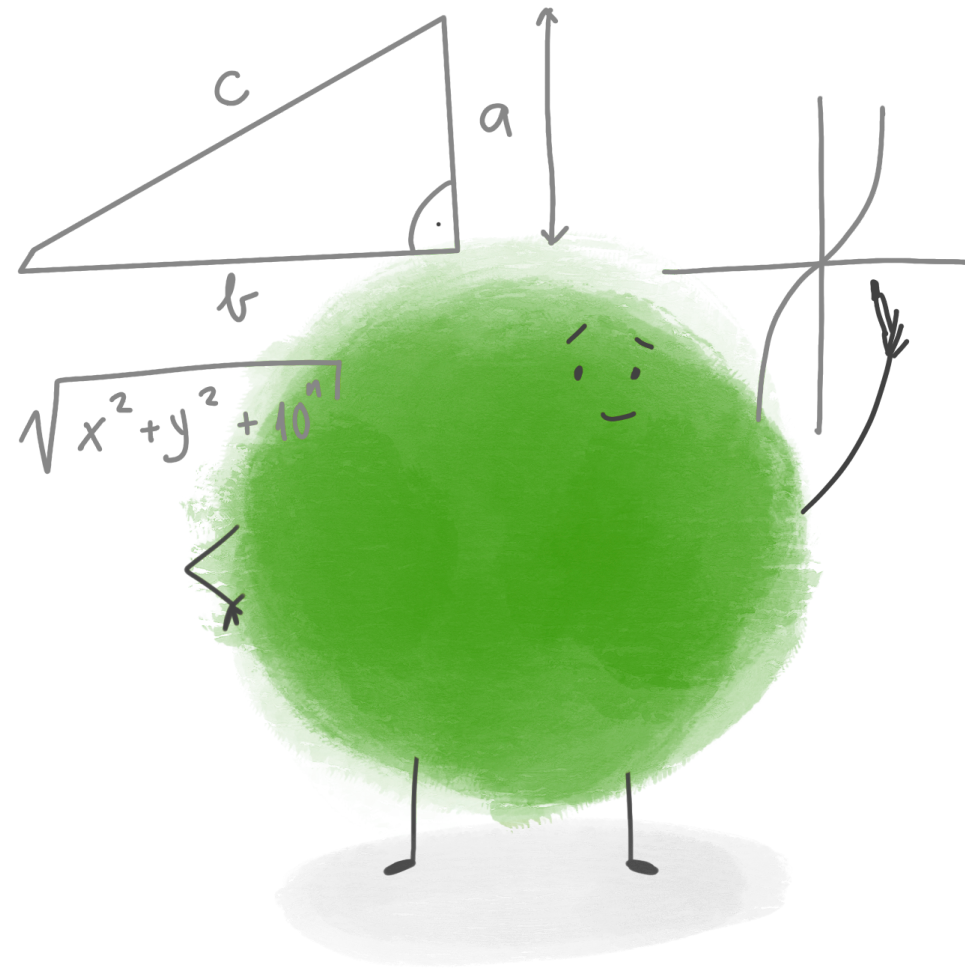
Creative maker

testing out ideas



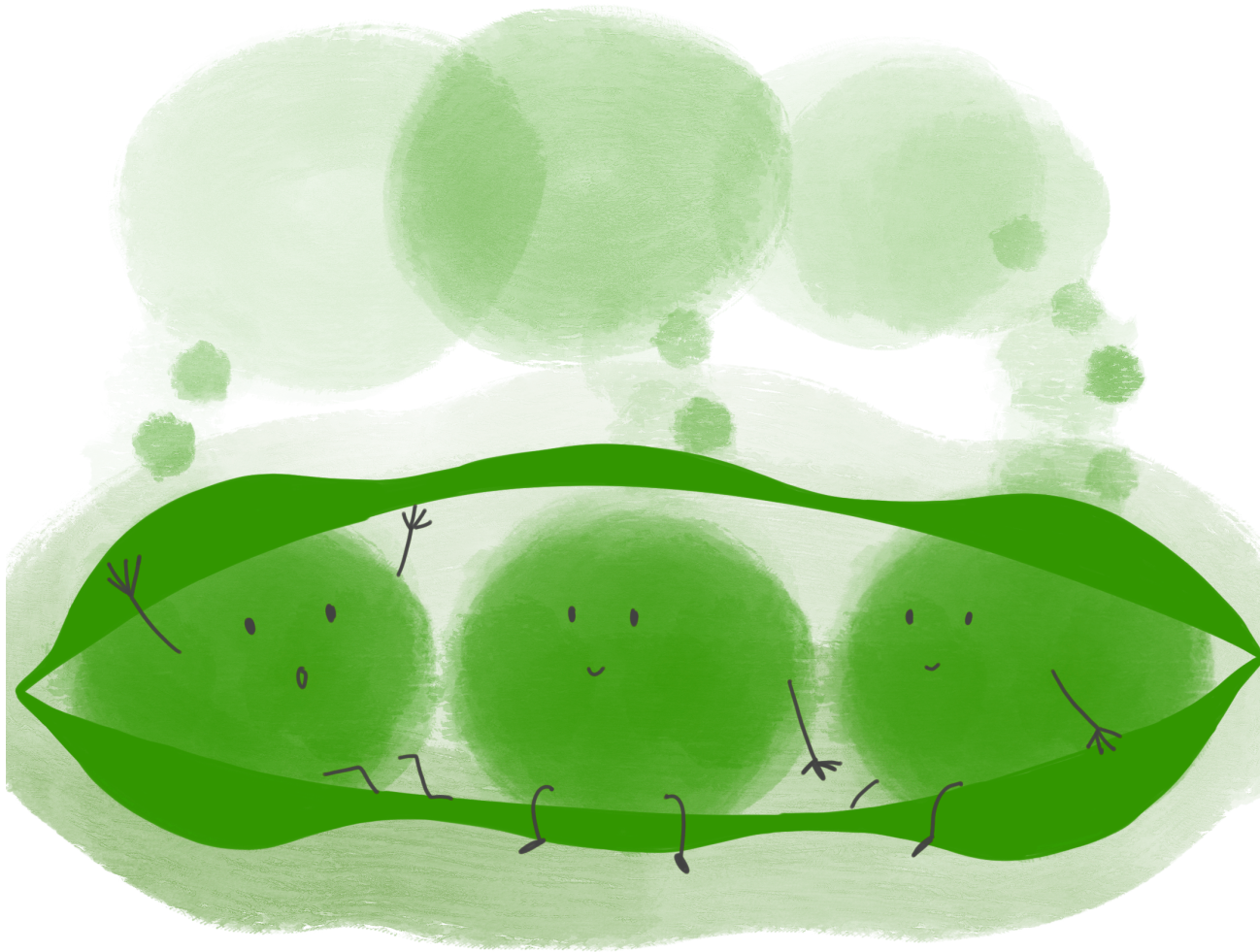
Analytical problem solver

connecting ideas to real life



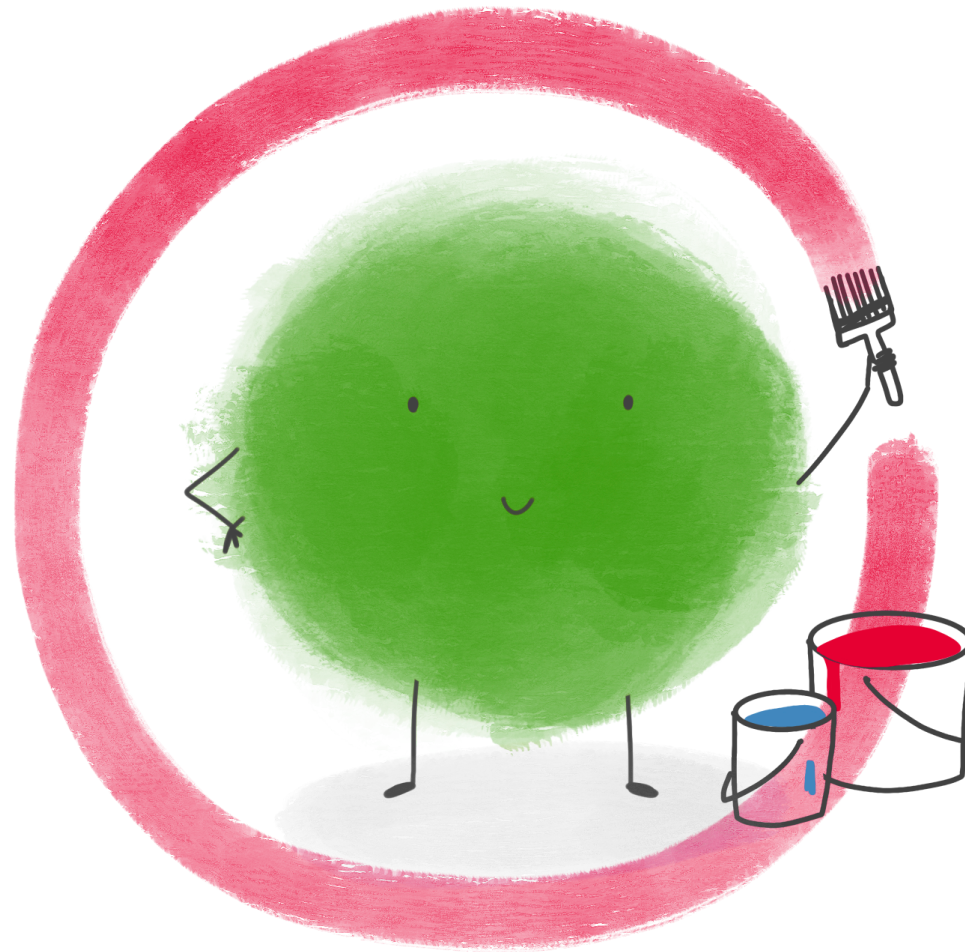
Collaborative connector

discussing, and working with others



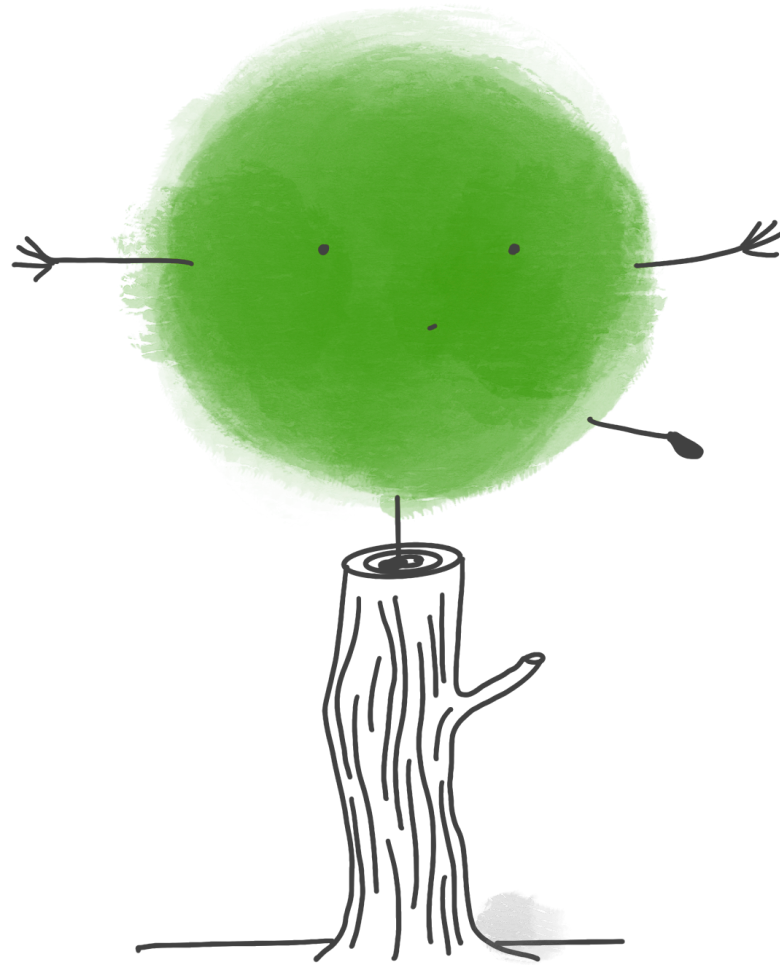
Empathetic listener

thinking about possibilities



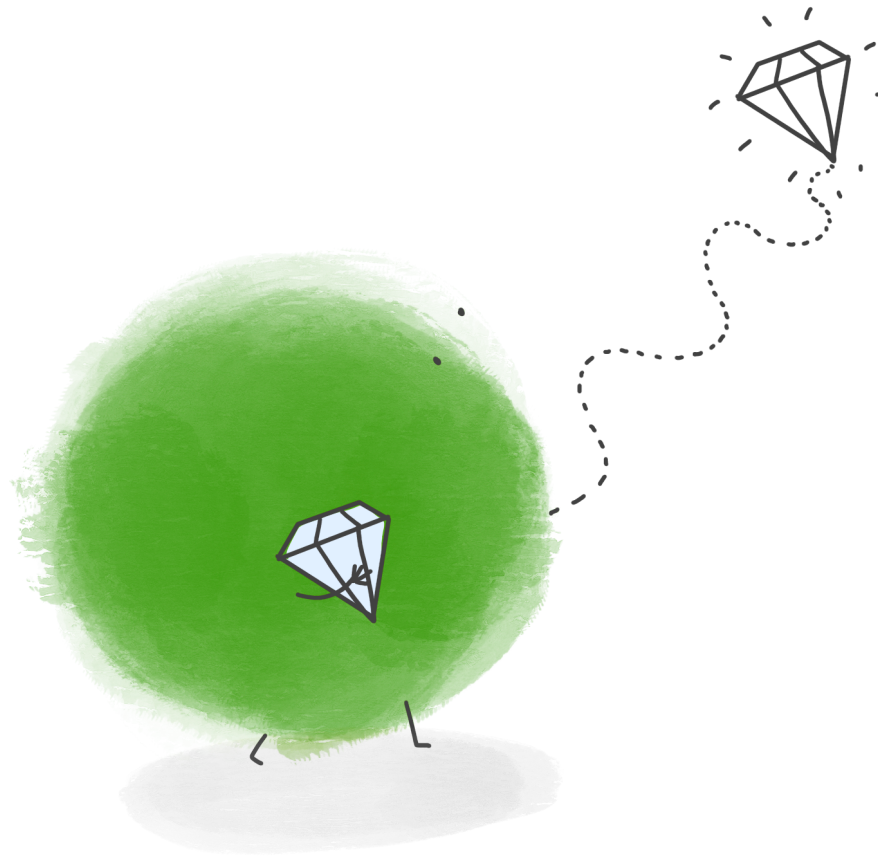
Body learner

doing things physically



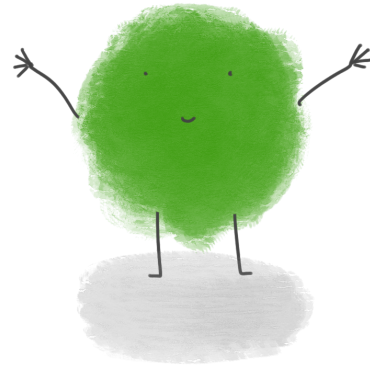
Growth adventurer
